### **Back-to-School Wraps**

### You'll need:

- 2 tablespoons light mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons mustard
- 3 large (8-inch) multigrain tortillas • 5 ounces sliced turkey or ham
- 6 slices cheddar cheese
- 1/2 red bell pepper, cut into strips What to do:

### • 1/2 cup peeled and chopped cucumber

- 6 sweet pickle slices
- 1 (2 1/4-ounce) can sliced black olives
- 1 1/2 cups shredded lettuce



an adult's help

- 1. Mix mayonnaise and mustard together and spread evenly on 3 large tortillas. 2. Cover each tortilla with thin slices of meat. Layer 2 slices of cheese on each.
- 3. Layer other ingredients on tortillas toward the middle to make rolling up easier.
- 4. Roll each tortilla tightly into a long cylinder. Cut each wrap in half. Secure with a toothpick if necessary. Makes 3 large or 6 smaller sandwich wraps.
