

Placing your Tampa Bay Times Newspaper in Education (NIE) Request for 2012-2013



To place your request for print or electronic copies of the *Tampa Bay Times* for school year 2012-2013, visit tampabay.com/nie and click on “Place your request here for the 2012-2013 school year”.

Teachers, you will need to provide the following information when placing your request:

- Your full first and last name
- Complete school name, address and phone number
- A valid email address that you check on a regular basis
- A valid non-work contact phone number

You will be required to enter the total number of students that you teach each day. Please be as accurate as possible. **Please be aware that NIE has a limited number of print newspapers available. As a result, all requests are limited to a maximum of 50 copies of the daily print newspaper, per teacher, per week plus a maximum of 15 copies of the Sunday print newspaper, per teacher, per week.**

We are proud to be among the few newspapers in the nation still providing free print newspapers to schools. These newspapers are provided due to the generosity of the *Tampa Bay Times* leadership, our subscribers and members of our community who sponsor classroom newspapers.

Demand for copies of the print newspaper far exceeds our supply. **In request to serve as many teachers as possible with the limited resources available to us, teacher requests for print newspapers will be prioritized using the following criteria:**

- 2011-2012 affidavit completion
- School’s Title I status
- School’s level of access to technology
- School’s population of at-risk and below-grade-level readers

We encourage you to supplement the print edition of the newspaper with the electronic edition.

The number of licenses you need should equal the number of computers that will access the electronic edition at the same time. **The electronic edition of the Times is an exact replica of the printed paper.** It can be accessed on any computer with Internet access, eReader device (Kindle, Sony eReader, Nook) or electronic tablet (iPad or android).

The Tampa Bay Times NIE program is governed by the Audit Bureau of Circulations. All newspapers must be used in classroom settings. Newspapers cannot be requested for the front office or lunchrooms. You will be required to electronically sign an affidavit confirming you have received the newspapers and used them for educational purposes.
