\$1000 Scholarship

Graduating <u>public high school seniors</u> are eligible to apply for a \$1000 Pasco Art of Recycling scholarship at www.pascoeducationfoundation.org

Students must have a 2.0 GPA, be enrolled in a program for art or environmental science, and must have entered artwork during the 2016 or any of the previous three (3) Pasco Art of Recycling contests (<u>Applications will be verified</u>). See your guidance counselor for more information on the Scholarship application deadline.

Competition Criteria:

The competition is open to all High School students who attend a public, private, or home school in Pasco County. Due to space requirements, schools are limited to a maximum of seven (7) entries per school. Competitions will be held at the school level to determine the seven school finalists to be entered into the Art of Recycling Contest. There is no limit to the number of entries at the school level.

Art entries must be comprised of at least 70% recycled (discarded or used) materials and have an environmental theme. Each art entry must be ready for presentation and be no larger than 42 inches in any direction. All types of art media are encouraged. See additional guidelines & requirements located on official 2016 Art of Recycling application.

Art entries can include

• Painting • Printmaking • Sculpture • Ceramics • Wearable Art • Architecture

To Enter:

- Pick up an Entry Form from your High School Art teacher and enter your school's competition.
- Be chosen as one of your school's seven finalists (Art teacher must initial form).
- Fill out the application <u>completely</u> and tape directly to your art entry.
- Deliver your art entry to the West Pasco County Government Center on Friday, January 29, 2016 between 2:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- One entry per student. No group art will be accepted.
