What is **my news...on the go?**

My News...On the Go is an electronic replica of the newspaper accessed through the internet with a secure login

- Peruse the newspaper by browsing through the pages
- Read stories in the newspaper format or click on the title to view just the text



Logging In

1. Open your internet browser and go to <http://www.mynewsonthego/waco>
2. Enter your user name and password
3. Click Sign In



My Subscriptions



1. Once logged in, you will see the current day's edition

2. Click on the thumbnail to open the ePaper



3. A separate window will appear with the front page of the newspaper

ePaper Reader

The ePaper Reader displays the selected page in the main window and thumbnail images of the front pages of each section.

The following pages will demonstrate the functionality of the ePaper Reader.



Navigating the ePaper Reader

Stories Tab: This feature is currently not in use

Search: Type a key word to search the current edition

Browse: Click the arrows to view the previous/next page or select the desired page number of the selected section from the pull down menu

Jumps: Click on page links and story jumps to continue reading an article or click on the title to read the story in text format.

A man was injured in a car accident Tuesday while trying to get to his burning North Waco home, where 10 members of his family were rushing to escape fast-spreading flames.

The crash was taken to Hillcrest Baptist Medical Center for a head injury, said Waco Fire Marshal Jerry Hawk. Five of members died.

Navigating the ePaper Reader

Page Turner: The green arrow will appear as you hover your mouse over the arrow to turn the page, either backward or forward.

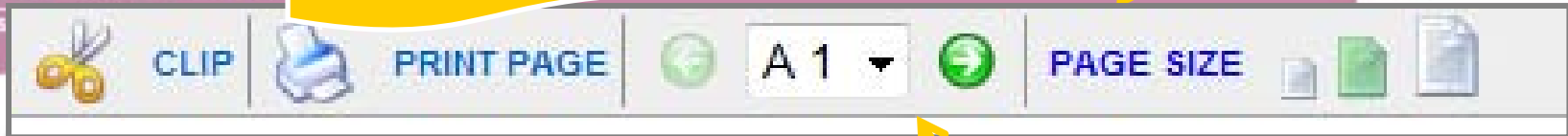
Save Section: Click on the Disk Icon to save an entire section to your computer.

Quick Browse: Click on arrows or select a page from the pull down menu to preview it. If you want to see the full page view, click on the image.

ePaper Reader Toolbar

PAGE Size: Selecting from three options to view the newspaper page in the size you prefer.

PRINT: Printing the page will shrink the page to fit to the size paper your printer holds.



CLIP: Click this icon to select a portion of the page, such as a picture or advertisement. Left click the mouse and drag the area you want to save. In the lower right hand corner of your selection, click on the Disk icon to either open or save the selection as a .jpeg file. You can also Print or email your selection. Click the X icon to exit the selection.



Browse: Click the arrows to view the previous/next page or select the desired page number of the selected section from the pull down menu
