Selected work will be published in *Pathways to Understanding: Creating Community through Allyship*, an original Newspaper in Education publication that will be published as a special section in the *Tampa Bay Times* and distributed to Tampa Bay high schools.

The goals of *Pathways to Understanding* are to give community members the opportunity to build relationships across and within faith communities and to increase understanding and promote inclusion for Muslims living in Tampa Bay.

Guidelines

Deadline: All entries must be received by **September 16, 2019**, 11:59 p.m. Times Publishing Company is not responsible for lost, late, damaged, illegible, misdirected, electronic malfunction or any other problems or errors in transmission or delivery of entries.

Entry: Entries must be submitted online at **tampabay.com/nie** to be considered. Artists and writers may submit an unlimited number of entries. There is no entry fee.

All entries must be original. Entries must comply with all applicable law governing intellectual property, including all laws governing copyright.

Each entry must be accompanied by the entrant's name, full mailing address, telephone number and email address. Submissions may be published pseudonymously or anonymously if desired.

Eligibility: Eligible participants include amateur and professional artists and writers in Citrus, Hernando, Hillsborough, Manatee, Pasco and Pinellas counties, who are at least 13 years of age on the date of entry, and who are legal residents of the State of Florida.

Specifications: Art submissions may be in any medium or combination of mediums. To submit a piece of art for consideration, you must upload or email a digital image of your art in JPEG format.

Photo submissions must be in JPEG format and at least 1024 x 768 pixels. Photos should not include children under 12 years of age. If photos of buildings are submitted, they must be taken from public property and cannot include sculptural elements such as statues, stained glass windows or mosaics.

Written submissions should be in a Word (doc or docx) or Portable Document Format (pdf) format. The maximum word count is 500.
