## Johana Wright Hillsborough High School, Hillsborough County 2020 NIE Teacher of the Year Honorable Mention

Johana is the instructor for CHOICE Academy within Hillsborough High School in Hillsborough County.

CHOICE Academy assists young adults with autism and intellectual disabilities in developing skills to be successful participants in their community. Additionally, it gives students ages 18-21 the opportunity to experience personal growth and community exploration.

Johana was chosen as a 2020 NIE Teacher of the Year Honorable Mention for her use of the Tampa Bay Times to help her students become independent adults.

Johana has used the Tampa Bay Times in her classroom for several years. In 2019-20, she decided to implement the major concept "Employment and Community Resources" differently using the BayLink section of the Times as a supplement to the existing curriculum.

First, the students learned how to find, read and understand job advertisements.

Next, they learned how to identify jobs for which they had the necessary skills, and which interested them.

Finally, they completed a graphic organizer to identify how to find out more about the jobs and how to apply. The organizer required students to list each job, the address, website, phone number and email address, and whether the job was close to their home address.

The goal of this ongoing lesson is to prepare students to seek and maintain a job and, ultimately, become independent.
