Lisa teaches gifted students at Claywell Elementary School in Hillsborough County.

Lisa was chosen as a 2024 Honorable Mention for using the newspaper to find realworld examples that connect academic subjects to the world outside of school.

Lisa uses the Times on an ongoing basis to find real-world math problems for her students to solve. She will pose a problem or scenario. Students then collaborate to solve the problem or to make up their own problems based on the given scenario, based on what they are able to find in the newspaper. They then share their solutions or problems with the class.
